SPRING 2022 ASSESSMENT PERIOD

April 25 - May 20

All spring scores must be entered into the PALS website by June 3, 2022.

Virginia Public Schools/EIRI Spring Screening Requirements

All students may be assessed. The following are required:

- Kindergartners
- First graders
- Second graders without a *PALS High Benchmark* designation

Consult your *PALS Division Representative* for any additional requirements.

Spring Testing Notes

Change in Modify Student Information page. The Disability Designation has been REMOVED from the Student Information page. You will no longer report a student's disability designation in PALS; you will ONLY report the Administration Conditions (Standard, Non-Standard, or Exempt). Please remember that changes in Administration Conditions must be made before scores are entered.

Remote/Hybrid. You will be prompted to indicate and confirm your choice after selecting the score entry link. PLEASE choose carefully so scores will not have to be re-entered. The majority of students are now **in-person**.

COW. Like last year, teachers will not be administering *COW* this spring. As soon as the first task is entered, Kindergarten *COW* will populate with 3s and 1–3 will populate with 0s. This means the max score in K will be 95, and the Summed Score Benchmark is 83 — just like last Spring.

Level C: Blending and Sound-to-Letter tasks are:

- Optional for Kindergarten
- Only required in 1–3 if:
 - A student is required to complete *Level B* (*Alphabetics*), or
 - You optionally enter *Alphabet Recognition* and *Letter Sounds*.

Materials. Continue with Form A (GREEN) *PALS* materials for Spring 2022

 Spring 2022 consumable materials can be downloaded from within your PALS account.

Reports. Fall and Mid-Year reports are now in the *Previous Terms* section of the *Reports* page. The *Assess* page shows reports from the current assessment period only. Examine your Fall and Mid-Year reports to decide which, if any, additional tasks to administer to best show progress.

Quick Checks. Hover over *Assess* and select *Quick Checks* to access all *Quick Checks* materials, actions, and reports.

Revised Literacy Screener. We are excited to share news about our literacy screener being updated and expanded. Check your *Home* tab, *Recommendations* section for updates. Please note (and don't panic!) we are only in the piloting stage. The new screener will not be released prior to Fall 2024. Looking at Data

- Meeting the Task or Summed Score Benchmark does
 not imply that a student is on grade level. The Below
 Summed Score Identification (ID) status indicates that
 a student is at significant risk of ongoing reading
 difficulties. Students who score just above the Summed
 Score Benchmark and/or who do not meet Individual
 Task Benchmarks are also in need of additional classroom
 instruction.
- Spring is a season for progress! Most often, when students have stalled in reading, the culprit is phonemic awareness or phonics and is demonstrated in phonics/ spelling scores. Use the *Spelling/Phonics Knowledge* report found on your *Reports* tab to see which features students still need. *There is still time to solidify crucial spelling features this spring!*

Professional Learning Resources

Looking Ahead (Fall 2022)

Reports. Print or save any necessary 2021–2022 class/ student reports for your files. When the website moves to the next school year, student accounts move into the "School Pool". **Your** *Class Summaries* and all your classview reports will only be available until June 30th.

• Administrators. Consider printing/saving Class Summaries for your files. When the website moves to the next school year, it will be impossible to see former class summaries. Reports are available through June 30th.

Materials. In the 2022–2023 school year Form B (BLUE) materials will be used. We will be mailing schools a few pages to add to each existing *PALS-K* binder. Each set contains administration instructions for the optional *Blending* and *Sound-to-Letter* tasks. The "Newly Expanded PALS" will not be in circulation until at least 2024, so your blue binders are all up to date.
